Rules:

1. The annual subscription for 2017 is £569.00. The membership year commences on 1 April, however a person may join after this date and will pay pro-rata the remainder of the year's subscription. Resignation will be accepted at the end of any subscription year, but must be received by 31 March.
2. £50 extra will be charged which will be credited to the Associate Member's Bewacard (swipe card) for use over the bar on drinks/food.
3. There will be no entrance fee upon joining unless the member transfers to a gold, silver or bronze category within the first 12 months and a joining fee is in place at that time.
4. The Associate Member may attend any AGM/SGM but has no voting rights, nor do they have any interest in the property or funds of the Club.
5. The period of Associate Membership will be for a maximum of two years after which the player will be required to either transfer to a formal category of membership or resign. The associate scheme is intended for those new to golf or those returning to golf after an absence of a minimum two years.
6. They may transfer to another playing membership category during the two year period by application to the Manager/Secretary. No interview will be required until the member wishes to move to another category. The Associate Member must agree to abide by the rules of the Club and will be provided with a rule book and all necessary documentation and guidance.
7. The Associate Member will be able to utilise all the Club's facilities currently available to other members.
8. 36 holes per week allowed included in the above subscription on any day except Tuesday before 2.30pm (1.30pm in winter) and Saturdays before 2.30pm. Players should ensure that they check to ensure that the tee is available preferably prior to arrival. The onus will be on the Associate Member to ensure they do not exceed the allowance – however they may have extra at a cost of £17.50 per round which should be paid in the Professional's shop prior to play.
9. Players cannot enter any official Shipley Club competition, excepting an open competition (e.g. Seniors Open days/Gents Open day), providing they have obtained a handicap and the handicap is 'competitive'.
10. If in any week the full allowance is not played, none can be carried over to another week.
